Welcome to 2023 everyone! According to Chinese astrology, each year is the year of a particular animal. This is the Year of the rabbit. Many people in Japan say that they can see Mochitsuki Rabbits when they look at the surface of the moon. However, I heard that there are many people in the United States who say that they can see human faces on the surface of the moon. I think it's just a difference in how we perceive the image of the pattern, but today I would like to share a story about why rabbits are said to be on the moon. Have you ever heard the story of "Rabbit's donation"? It is a story about three animals and a monk.

A long time ago, an old monk fell down on a mountain. Three animals, a rabbit, a fox and a monkey, happened to pass by. They decided to help the monk. They said, "Let's collect something to eat for him first." Each of the three went to find food. The fox caught fish in the river and the monkey picked up nuts but the rabbit could find nothing. Wanting to help the monk but finding no food, the rabbit had an idea. It is the offering of his own meat. The rabbit said to the monk, "I will jump into the fire now. When my body is burnt, please eat its meat and continue your practice." And when he was about to jump into the fire without hesitation, the old monk transformed into Taishakuten. *Taishakuten is the guardian deity of Buddhism. The man pretending to be an old monk was actually Taishakuten, and he was testing three animals. Taishakuten was moved by the rabbit's firm determination, praised it, and drew a large picture of the rabbit on the moon in order to make the rabbit's compassionate deeds known to the world.

Rabbit found no food to donate. However, he desperately wanted to contribute to Buddhism, so he tried to give his own life. This is not something that can be done easily. In such a way, there is a donation that seems to be easy even in daily life. It is "The seven free donations."

[Gense - Donation by eye] To look with gentle eyes when talking to others.

[Wagense - Donation by face] To talk to people with a smile.

[Aigose - Donation by words] To speak beautiful words with love.

[Shinse - Donation by body] To use the body to help people.

[Shinse - Donation by heart] To have a caring heart for others.


[Shouzase - Donation by place] To give the seat or position to the next person.

[Boujyase - Donation by home] Welcoming people into your home. For example, shelter from the rain.

Ho-Onko Service (Memorial Service for Shinran Shonin)

The Ho-Onko Service is an annual memorial service to remember the life and teachings of our founder, Shinran Shonin. It is from Shinran's writings and his understanding of the historical Buddha's enlightenment and essence of the teaching of the historical Buddha, that our practice of Buddhism was founded.

He passed away on January 16, 1263 at the age of 90. After he passed away, many followers remembered him by gathering together and having a service on his memorial day every year. For the Shinran Shonin's 33rd year memorial service, Kakunyo Shonin, the 3rd Monshu of Hongwanji decided on the system of the ceremony and composed "Ho-Onko-Shiki" to praise Shinran Shonin's virtue. Since then, Jodo Shinshu followers have observed the Ho-Onko Service on the memorial day of Shinran Shonin for approximately 759 years. This is observed to recall and appreciate Shinran Shonin, and listen to the Nembutsu teachings. This service is the most important service for Jodo Shinshu followers.

Governing Board Meeting Highlights
Meeting Date: December 8, 2022

1. BCF Financial Status: As of November 30, 2022, the BCF revenues are \$141,935 and expenses are \$124,735. The budget for the year is \$147,500.
2. BCF Youth Protection Policies and Best Practices– compliance with California Law AB506. Lois Kashiwase will send out reminders to BCF affiliates to comply with the requirements of AB 506. All individuals over eighteen who meet the compliance requirements must be certified by California DOJ by January 1, 2023. Glenn Fujii shared the Sacramento Buddhist Church policy and procedures as an informational document.
3. Long Range Facilities Planning: Committee will start working on securing bids for the perimeter fencing project in January 2023.
4. Church Reopening: Discussion to restart church activities (i.e., Sr. Lunch program, allowing otoki after funeral/memorial services). E. Fujii shared proposed reopening guidelines, which are based on the Sacramento Buddhist Church guidelines. E. Fujii to determine the maximum occupancy for BCF facilities for discussion at the next BCF Board meeting

5. Dharma School field trip – Plans are being made to visit the Berkely Buddhist Temple, tour the Jodo Shinshu Center and the University of California Berkeley campus in March or April 2023. Contact Lois Kashiwase if interested in joining the field trip.
6. Audio/visual committee proposal to mount two monitors in the Hondo on the front of the onaijin was not approved and the project has been tabled. BCF thanks Stuart Ito from Sacramento Betsuin for his help and for putting together the proposal.
7. The BCF survey tool, updated BCF Directory and donation envelopes will be distributed to the Sangha at the January 22, 2023, Ho-Onko Service. The Survey is due back by March 1, 2023.
8. Membership chair – Reminder letters will be sent to those delinquent on their dues. The 2023 BCF Membership payment is due January 1, 2023. The membership form will be in the newsletter.
9. Scrip Program – the amount raised from 2021 is \$2,632.97.
10. Kianna Nakaoka has requested proposed projects for her Eagle Scout project. One proposed project is to paint the interior of the parsonage and possibly the exterior of the parsonage.

Kikuyo and Kinjiro Nakatani Public School Teacher Grant Recipient

Cindy DeGuzman is a recipient of a Kikuyo and Kinjiro Nakatani Public School Teacher Grant in the amount of \$1,500. Cindy teaches 5th grade at Barbara Comstock Morse Elementary School in the Elk Grove Unified School District. With the grant award, she plans to purchase a class set of the book, Journey to Topaz, and other supplemental materials to teach about the incarceration of Japanese Americans during World War II. Cindy also plans to purchase art supplies for Social Emotion Learning (SEL) and Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA). Both SEL and VAPA are emphasized curriculum items for the emotional health of students during COVID.

The Kikuyo and Kinjiro Nakatani Public School Teacher Grants are available to church members who teach in public schools. Grant applications are being accepted for the 2022-23 school term. The Buddhist Church of Florin supports public school teachers by offering a \$1,500 grant for classroom supplies and education materials; and if necessary, for Personal Protection supplies and equipment.

To be eligible for the Kikuyo and Kinjiro Nakatani Public School Teacher Grant, you must be a full-time public school teacher in Kindergarten through 12th grade; and a member of the Buddhist Church of Florin (church membership dues are paid and current).
