Hello May! In May, we are having Memorial Day and Gotanye services, which is Shinran Shonin's birthday and classes such as cooking, discussion and Japanese language classes. This might be a good chance to learn travel-friendly Japanese for our group trip to Japan in 2026. In the cooking class, we will be making sushi bake. To explain sushi bake simply, it is crab sticks (imitation crab meat) chopped and mixed with sour cream, mayonnaise, sriracha sauce, sesame oil, etc., then placed on top of furikake rice, baked, and wrapped in Korean nori seaweed. Please join us in our service, classes and annual visit to the cemetery.

The picture above is of Shinran Shonin receiving the Tokudo ceremony as a child. He received his Tokudo ceremony and became a monk when he was 9 years old. I received my Tokudo ceremony when I was 23 years old, so I can appreciate how young Shinran was. I am not sure how Tokudo today differs from that of Shinran Shonin's time, but even in my time it was hard. I had a friend who chanted sutras for a long time while seiza (sitting on the floor with legs folded), and lost consciousness.

At this time, Shinran Shonin had the Yomei (childhood name), Matsuwaka Maru. "Yomei" refers to the childhood name that children use until they reach adulthood. When they became adults, they were given their adult names. During the Warring States period, many young children lost their lives to illness, so childhood names were given to children with the hope that they would reach adulthood safely. We will hold Gotanye service on his birthday to express our gratitude to Shinran Shonin, who survived difficult times and spread the teachings of Nembutsu.


May Monthly Memorial (Shotsuki Hoyo) Service


