All Lives Embraced by Amida Buddha's compassion



Hello everyone. In November, we will have our Pet Memorial Service.

I often receive this question: "Do pets go to the Pure Land? Can they become Buddhas?"

Amida Buddha made a vow to bring every life to the Pure Land without leaving anyone behind.

Honen Shonin spread the importance of reciting the Nembutsu, and Shinran Shonin went even deeper. He said that even if we cannot recite the Nembutsu, we are already embraced by Amida Buddha's compassion. No one is left out of Amida Buddha's salvation.

If only those who can recite the Nembutsu are saved, then people who cannot hear and do not know how to pronounce Namo Amida Butsu would not be able to be born in the Pure Land. But that is not true. Amida Buddha finds a special way to reach every life. For those who cannot hear, there is a way for them. For pets, there is a way for them. Amida Buddha already prepared the path for each life to be born in the Pure Land.

This comes from the vows Amida made when he was the Bodhisattva Dharmakara. He said, "I will bring every living being to my Pure Land. If I cannot do this, I will not become a Buddha." He also said, "If my Name cannot reach all times and all places, I will not become a Buddha."

Today we can hear and recite Namo Amida Butsu. Because of this, we know that his vow has been fulfilled. This Name was not made by me, not by my parents, and not even by Shinran Shonin. It is the word that Amida Buddha prepared long ago, to reach me living in this present world.

The fact that Namo Amida Butsu comes from my mouth now is proof that Dharmakara has truly become Amida Buddha. It also means that his vow "to bring all beings to the Pure Land" has already come true. Because if that vow had not been fulfilled, he could not yet be a Buddha.

Therefore, we all can be born in the Pure Land. It is the place where we will meet again with our old friends, family, ancestors, and also our beloved pets, meeting each other as Buddhas.

Through the Pet Memorial Service, we can hear about that wonderful world, and even though we cannot see it yet, we can still feel peace and joy here and now. The teaching of the Buddha is always for us who are living in this present world.

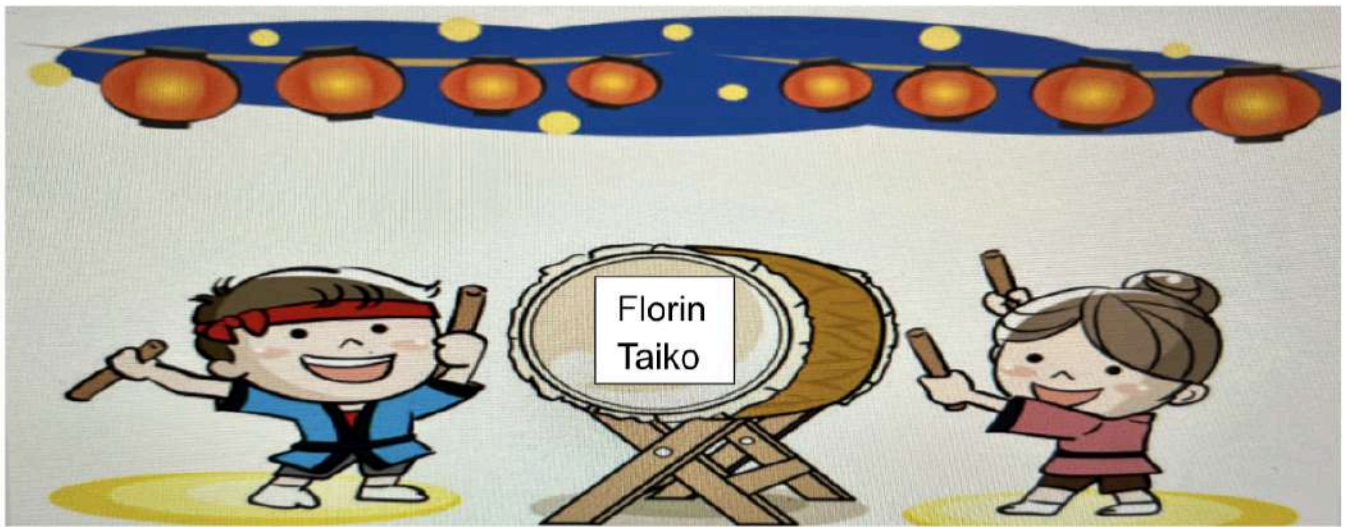

Who may participate? Up to 20 Buddhist Church of Florin members and a representative from an affiliated organization.

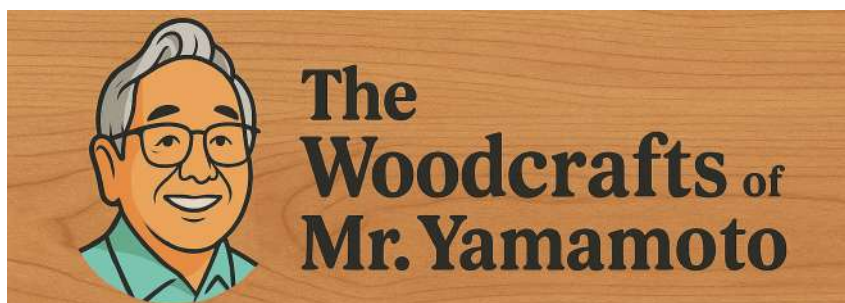
Where will it be? The Red Cross trainer will conduct training at the Buddhist Church of Florin.

The Promise of “KANARAZU”

On a small handmade wooden craft, one simple word was carved: KANARAZU, which means “surely” or “without fail.”

At first, it looks like just one strong word. But when we think deeply, it carries a very heavy meaning. In our human life, we know how difficult it is to keep our promises. Sometimes we fail, or we are disappointed by others. The word “surely” is not easy for us to say.

But Amida Buddha’s “surely” is different. It comes from the great vow:
“I will surely bring you to the Pure Land. ”

This is not a promise that depends on our effort or strength. It is a promise already given to all living beings, a voice of infinite compassion.

When I looked at that wooden carving of KANARAZU, I felt that the Buddha’s voice was quietly alive inside the wood. The warmth of the wood reminded me of the warmth of Amida’s vow, always holding, always watching over.

Maybe this little craft is more than art. Maybe it is a small shape of Amida’s promise, a message that says, “You are never forgotten.”
